

## **Q/A session on on the Provision of the services for biomass waste transportation / processing to briquette / pellet - Reference 81277323/RDASrem/TD7**

### **Question 1.**

In the ToR it is declared the agricultural waste will be vineyard / orchard pruning residuals. As per our investigations it is very hard to collect 300t of such residuals, having given no proper equipment for biomass compacting in Srem region (balling machines). Can we collect / process green cuts for public areas maintenance / garden cutting, which is also biomass residuals to supplement the quantities of the biomass necessary to achieve ToR targets?

### **Answer 1.**

Yes, the green cuts biomass from green areas / gardens can be used for biomass fuel production.

### **Question 2.**

We will opt to use pellet / briquette lines on the PUC Regionalna deponija Srem Mačva. From our previous insights on the Landfill area, we found certain quantities of the biomass are already stocked on the Landfill site. Could we arrange to use some of this biomass for the processing of the 300t of the biomass, for sake of decrease the risk of biomass. We will arrange the overtake of those biomasses with PUC on our own cost's w/o additional charging of the CA, i.e. with your positive response we will include the costs for those biomass in our final offer.

### **Answer 2.**

Contractor is free to arrange collection / processing of any kind of biomass which belongs to the vine guard / orchard / green cuts from green area / garden maintenance. The overall costs for biomass collection / processing should be given in the financial offer.

### **Question 3.**

If you allow the approach as per 2) – usage of the biomass from green cuts on the Landfill, can we use the one which is sorted on the landfill earlier, but not earlier then Y2022, to prevent biomass over drying?

### **Answer 3.**

Contractor is free to arrange collection / processing of any kind of biomass, but having as the main criterion the biomass fuel quality must be (in accordance with standard ISO 17225). The Contractor can use earlier collected biomass only if it will secure quality standards for produced biomass fuel.
